Dear Valued Customer:

We are aware that the EU Directive entitled "Restriction on the use of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) 2002/95/EC & "Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment" (WEEE) 2002/96/EC," will become effective on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2006 and will restrict the use of six substances within electrical and electronic equipment from that date.

The substances are:

RoHS Material	CAS #
Lead (Pb)	7439-92-1
Mercury (Hg)	7439-97-6
Cadmium (Cd)	7440-43-9
Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)	18540-29-9
Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	13654-09-6
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	32534-81-9

Taking into account our customer needs to comply with these directives by July 1<sup>st</sup> 2006, CMRSummit Technologies has implemented its RoHS program.

Any CMRSummit Technologies product containing RoHS materials and having lead-free solder finishes are fully (6/6 or 100%) RoHS compliant.

Any CMRSummit Technologies product containing RoHS materials and having Tin-Lead (SnPb) as an external finish are 5/6 RoHS compliant and qualify for RoHS lead (Pb) solder exemptions when used in high reliability equipment (such as telecommunications infrastructure equipment).

CMRSummit Technologies will supply certificates of compliance with all the products manufactured and shipped requiring compliancy to RoHS and WEEE directives.
